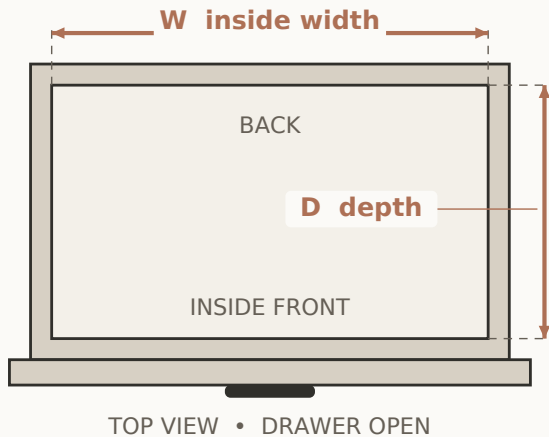


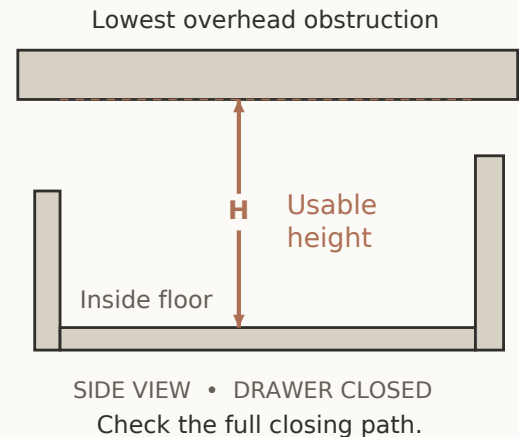
Measure your drawer.

A few careful measurements help us make a place for your everyday. Use this guide for drawers in your home or RV.

1. Width + depth



2. Usable height



Measure inside, in several places.

Empty the drawer. Measure width at the front, middle, and back, and depth on both sides. Send the smallest readings and note any taper or curve.

Check the height where it closes.

Measure from the inside floor to the lowest obstruction above the drawer along its closing path. Check rails, screws, and the frame. The drawer wall is not the height limit.

Keep the measurements as measured.

Use a straight tape or ruler. Record to the nearest 1/8 inch or 1 mm, keeping fractions. Do not subtract clearance. We will allow for fit in the design.

PHOTOS TO SEND

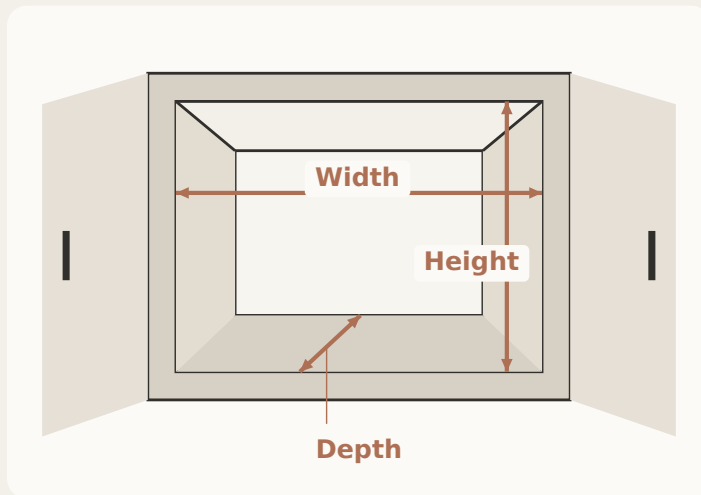
Send a top-down photo, a photo of the drawer in its cabinet, and close-ups of the ruler readings or any obstructions. Keep both measuring endpoints visible where possible.

If a drawer cannot open fully, tell us how much is accessible. We may use smaller sections so you can insert and remove them.

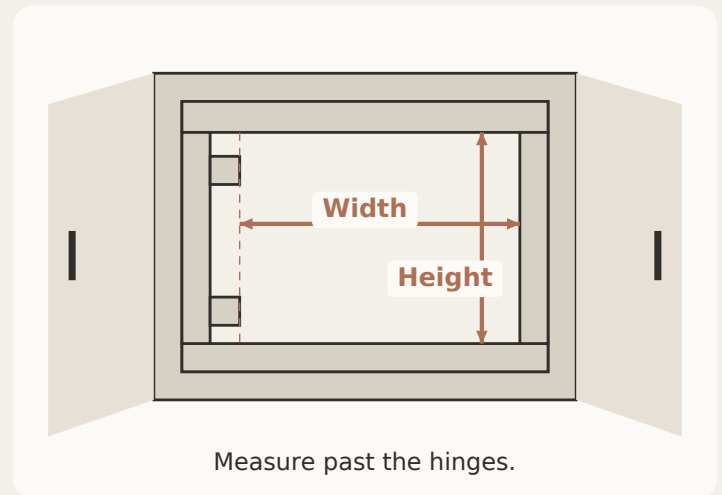
Measure your cabinet.

Open the doors and choose the shelf or compartment you want to organize. Take these measurements from the front, just as you use the cabinet.

1. Measure the space inside



2. Measure the opening



Inside: width, depth, and height.

Measure side to side, then from the front of the shelf to the back wall. Check that doors can close. Measure height from that shelf to the underside of the shelf or cabinet top above it.

Opening: width and height.

Open doors as far as you normally would. Measure the clear space past hinges and the frame. If a center post divides the opening, measure each side separately.

Check for anything in the way.

Note pipes, latches, or brackets. Check measurements in a few places and send the smallest readings. Do not subtract clearance. We will allow for fit.
